#### **1. Upload the following file:**

[catalog]includes\hooks\shop\system\\_28\_slimCheckout.php

#### **2. Delete the following file:**

[catalog]includes\hooks\shop\system\slimCheckout.php

## ***Update Version 1.9. to 1.10.***

### ***0. Backup your store and database***

#### **1. Upload the following new folder and file:**

[catalog]templates\override\includes\components\template\_top.php

Make sure your selected store template is "override": Admin : Configuration : My Store : Template Selection : override

Note: If you are using another template directory/name, copy the above file to your selected/used

directory instead of the "override" directory

## ***Update Version 1.8. to 1.9.***

### ***0. Backup your store and database***

#### **1. Upload and replace the following file:**

[catalog]/includes/system/override/slim\_checkout/osc\_template.php

## ***Update Version 1.7. to 1.8.***

### ***0. Backup your store and database***

#### **1. Upload and replace the following file:**

[catalog]/[admin]/includes/hooks/shop/system/slimCheckout.php

## ***Update Version 1.6. to 1.7.***

### ***0. Backup your store and database***

#### **1. Uninstall the "Slim Checkout" store module. (Modules -> Store -> Slim Checkout) Take note of your configuration settings**

#### **2. Upload and replace all files.**

#### **3. Install and configure the "Slim Checkout" store module. (Modules -> Store -> Slim Checkout)**

## ***Update Version 1.5. to 1.6.***

### ***0. Backup your store and database***

#### **1. Upload and replace the following file:**

[catalog]/includes/hooks/shop/system/slimCheckout.php

## ***Update Version 1.4. to 1.6.***

### ***0. Backup your store and database***

#### **1. Optional if you have any other files added to the slim\_checkout template:**

Copy all files except [catalog]/templates/slim\_checkout/includes/template.php  
from: [catalog]/templates/slim\_checkout/  
to: [catalog]/templates/override/

#### **2. Switch your template selection to the override template in :**

Admin -> Configuration-> My Store -> Template Selection: override

**3. Upload and replace the following files:**

```
[catalog]/includes/hooks/shop/system/slimCheckout.php
[catalog]/includes/modules/store/st_slim_checkout.php
[catalog]/includes/system/override/slim_checkout/osc_template.php
[catalog]/includes/system/override/slim_checkout/template.php
```

**4. Delete the following folder and all included files:**

```
[catalog]/templates/slim_checkout/
```
