Installation

- 1. Copy all new files from the "upload" folder into the appropriate store folders**
- 2. In Admin =>Modules => Store: Install and configure the module "Sloppy Words Cleaner".**
- 3. Make sure you are using the "override" template and have it selected in:**
Admin : Configuration : My Store : Template Selection
Otherwise you must copy:

TO:

In Admin =>Modules => Store: Install and configure the module "Sloppy Words Cleaner".

Enable Sloppy Words Cleaner

Main switcher for Sloppy Words Cleaner

Pages

Shows the pages where Sloppy Words Cleaner can be applied. Select the Pages were it should be used.

NOTE: If you add PWA Checkout Add-On at a later point, the file "account_pwa.php" will be added to the list without reinstalling the store module. But you need to activate the page in the list to apply Sloppy Word Cleaner.

Convert words

Array with word conversions which are considered exceptions from general "Prefix" or "All Lower" lists and can't be solved in the Exception Name list. Examples: MacKintosh:Mackintosh,Decicco:DeCicco
Or desired conversions: Sainte:Ste

Exception names

Surnames which are exceptions from general "Prefix" or "All Lower" lists. Including surnames here will prevent them to be converted if typed accurate in upper/lower case. Examples: "De Quincey" instead of "de Quincey", "La Rochefoucauld" instead of "la Rochefoucauld".

Prefixes

These are used for Surname and Address fields (Surnames are often used in Street Names and need the same exceptional treatment).

Examples: Mc,Mac,I',d',O',Dell'. This will convert the first letter following a prefix to upper case.

Suffixes

'S, Example: Sotheby's. letter following apostroph will be converted to lower case. Used for surname and address fields.

All lower case Names

List of short words which should be lower case in surnames. Used for surname and address fields.

Examples: Walter von der Vogelweide, Javier de la Rosa, Rainier de Monaco, Winfried van der Saar.

All upper case Names

By default empty. Can be used to convert certain words to all uppercase. Used for surname and address fields.

All lower case

List of short words which should be lower case in City names. Used for surname and address fields.

Examples: Stratford-upon-Avon, Boën-sur-Lignon, Sant Carles de la Ràpita

All upper case

List of acronyms which should be all upper case. Used for address and city fields.

Enable Company filter

By default, Company names are not filtered. It's supposed there is liberty for upper/lower case here.

All lower case Company

Used if Company filter is enabled for the Company field.

All upper case Company

Used if Company filter is enabled for the Company field.

All upper case Company

Used if Company filter is enabled for the Company field.

Convert specials

Converts all special characters like accents to standard ASCII characters.

This can be useful for countries in which language special characters are not common and may cause difficulties with shipping labels etc.

Default setting: false

Examples for difficult and exceptional cases by language:

English:

Firstname: MACDONALD -> Macdonald

Firstname: macdonald -> Macdonald

Surname: MACDONALD -> MacDonald

Surname: macdonald -> MacDonald

Surname: Macdonald -> Macdonald => correct spell match first letter upper all other lower -> no conversion.

It's supposed, knowing about his exceptional spelling, a "Macdonald" will take care to type his surname correct. J

Address: MACDONALD STREET -> MacDonald Street

Address: macdonald ave -> MacDonald AVE

Same for McDonald variants.

Exception: Mackintosh:

Surname: mackintosh -> Mackintosh

Surname: Mackintosh -> Mackintosh

Surname: MACKINTOSH -> Mackintosh

Adding: MacKintosh => Mackintosh to the word conversion array does the trick.

O'Hara -> prefix used

Exception: De Quincey

Surname: De Quincey -> De Quincey

Surname: de quincey -> de Quincey

Surname: DE QUINCEY -> de Quincey

Note: de is in the all lower list, De Quincey needs to be added to the exception list

It's supposed, knowing about his exceptional spelling, a "De Quincey" will take care to type his surname correct. J

City: wath-upon-dearne-> Wath-upon-Dearne

French:

d'Argent

Surname: d'Argent -> d'Argent

Surname: D'ARGENT -> d'Argent

Surname: d'argent -> d'Argent

Same for all the following:

de Beauvoir
du Plessix

Exception: La Rochefoucauld

Surname: LA ROCHEFOUCAULD -> La Rochefoucauld

Surname: la rochefoucauld -> La Rochefoucauld

Surname: la Rochefoucauld -> La Rochefoucauld

Same for "Le Corbusier"

Note: Le,La is not in the all lower list, it is always upper case, no problem

Surname: d'hauteville -> d'Hauteville

Address: CHEMIN DE L'ÉCLUSE-> Chemin de l'Écluse

Address: port-la-nouvelle-> Port-la-Nouvelle

Address: SAINTE-MARIE-SUR-MER -> Ste-Marie-sur-Mer

Note: A French user suggested these conversions for address:

"Saint" => "St", "Sainte" => "Ste", "Saints" => "Sts", "Saintes" => "Stes",

German:

Surname: von thurn und taxis -> von Thurn und Taxis

Surname: von der vogelweide -> von der Vogelweide

Surname: VON DER VOGELWEIDE -> von der Vogelweide

Address: heidenheim an der brenz-> Heidenheim an der Brenz

Netherland:

Surname: van der sar -> van der Sar

Note: if the surname stands alone, it should be Van der Sar, upper case, but if it is used together with the first name, lower case is correct. In OsCommerce first and second name stays always together: Edwin van der Sar

Address: DE WILP -> De Wilp

NOTE: First word always upper case if not name or street address

Spanish:

Firstname: josé m^a -> José M^a

Surname: DE LA ROSA -> de la Rosa

City: villares del saz-> Villares del Saz

Catalan:

City: LES MINES D'OSOR -> Les Mines d'Osor

Portuguese:

Surname: DOS SANTOS -> dos Santos

City: caldas da rainha -> Caldas da Rainha

City: Reguengo Do Fetal -> Reguengo do Fetal

Italian:

Surname: dell'atte -> Dell'Atte

Surname: degennaro -> DeGennaro

Note: several of these italian names are added to Word conversión list, adding to prefix list would break other all lower conversions like "der, die" and other terms beginning with "De, Di"

Surname: la russa-> La Russa

Surname: lavecchia -> LaVecchia

Note: Same problem like for Macdonald/MacDonald, both variants exist: Laveccia/LaVecchia
