If you wish to use it with third party modules, make sure the template file includes the module name as main class like the core modules:

Examples:

filename => class name:

bm\_whats\_new.php => bm-whats-new

cm\_header\_search.php => cm-header-search

## Installation:

***0a.) Backup your files***

***0b.) Backup your database***

***1. Upload all files included in the "uploads" directory maintaining their directory structure.***

All files are new and save to upload, they will not overwrite any existing files.

***2. Go to your Admin and install and configure your Hide Boxes Header Tag Module.***
